ACTION TAKEN ON THE BASIS OF

ACADEMIC AND ADMINISTRATIVE AUDIT REPORT

Action Taken on the basis of Annual Academic and Administrative Audit on 03/04/2020, 04/04/2020

- 1. A major recommendation in the audit was to start more Post Graduate Courses. As the state government invited application from colleges the institution applied for two new Post Graduate courses.
- 2. To enhance Curriculum enrichment departments were asked to start at least one Certificate course.
- 3. All departments were asked to document geo-tagged photos according to the new manual of NAAC.
- 4. Augmentation of Library facilities was one of the important recommendations. The management decided to construct a new library complex and the founding stone was laid.
- 5. IQAC instructed the departments to organise more capacity building programmes especially soft skill development programmes and computing skills and many programmes were organised by the departments.
- 6. Departments were asked to conduct programmes on Gender Equity and Energy Conservation
- 7. Those departments with relatively low pass percentage were asked to strengthen the remedial coaching and pre- exam preparations and help for the students.

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
